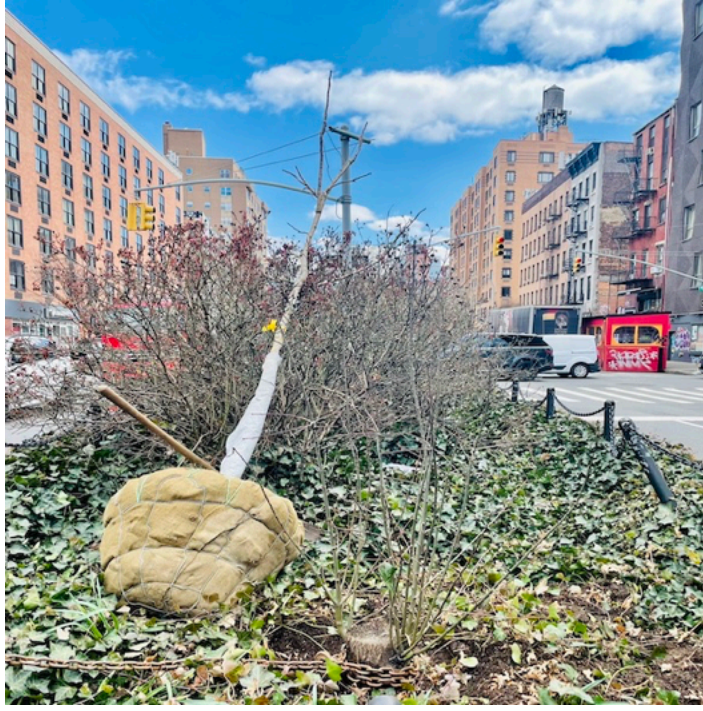


### Spring is Here, and We're Bringing New Life to the Streets

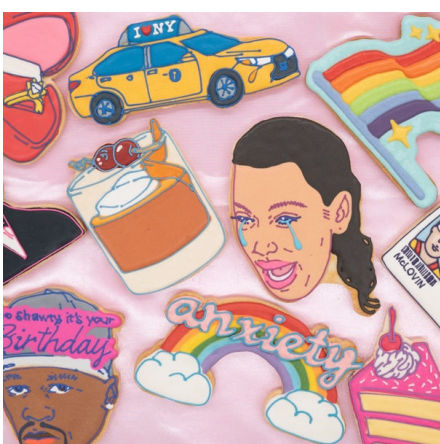
### An All New Showfields Debuts in NoHo
