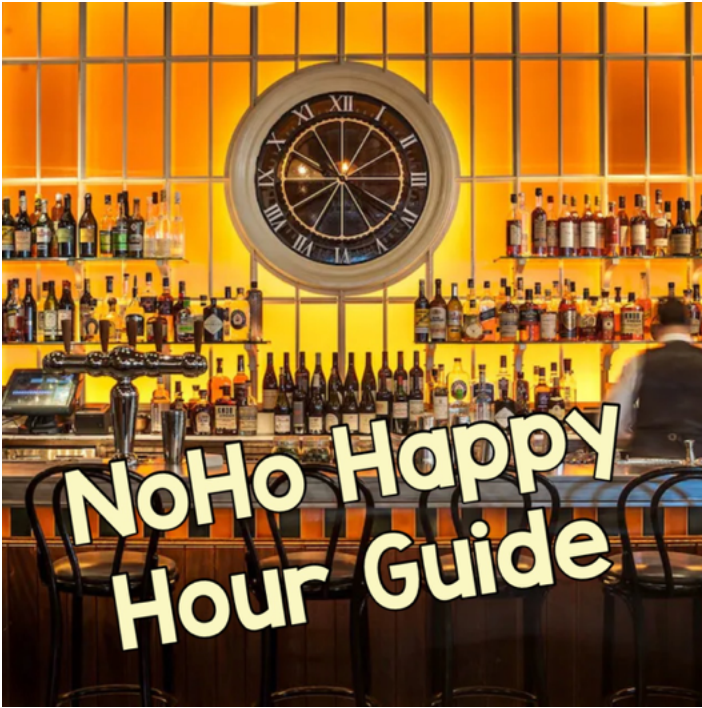
NoHo Summer Fall Garden Party Postponed to Wednesday, 9/7

NYC Landmarks Debuts New Business Express Service

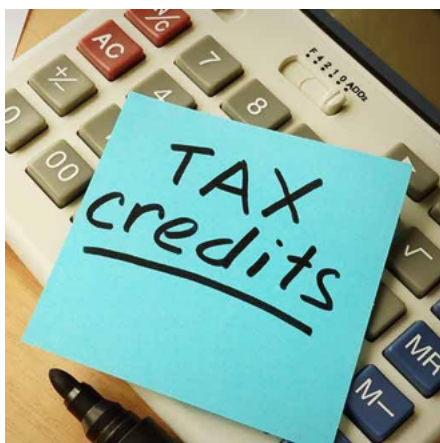
