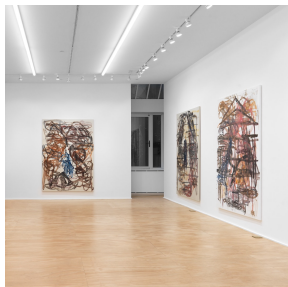


How to Spend a Rainy Day in the Neighborhood

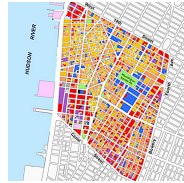
