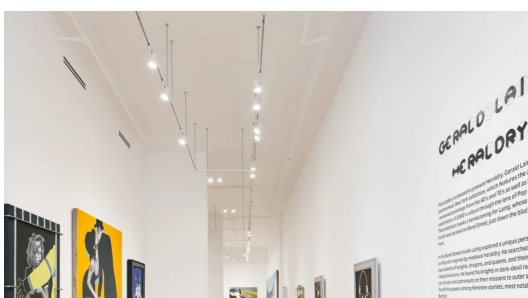
Here's What ChatGPT Thinks About NoHo

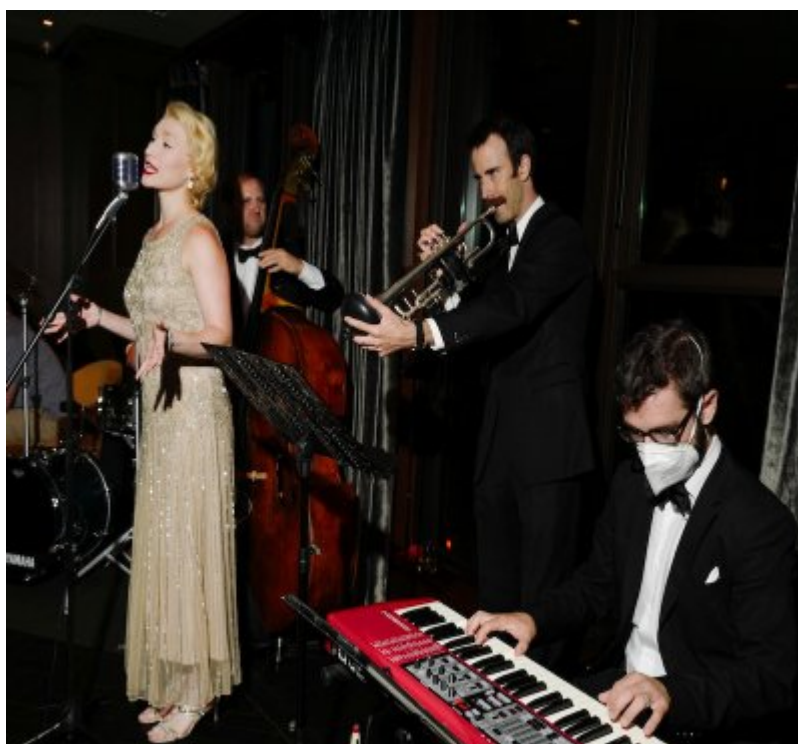

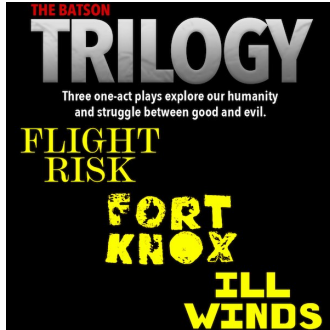

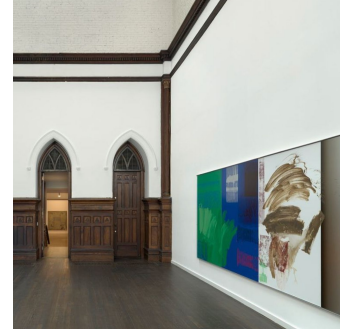
