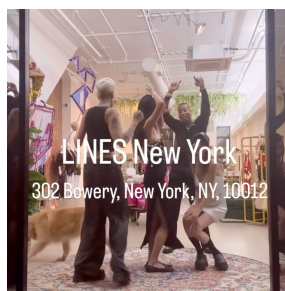

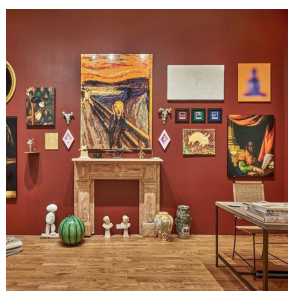
Welcome to the Bowery, LINES
