




This Women's History Month, Support NoHo's Female-Owned Businesses

Retail and Storefront Vacancy Trends in NoHo

Prior to COVID, NoHo was a neighborhood in transition, and our vacancies were higher than they are now. During the Pandemic, we spiked up to 32 vacancies in the neighborhood in January 2021. Since then, as the neighborhood has emerged, our vacancies have plummeted. The NoHo BID tracks two vacancy rates, the number of rentable stores and total vacancies. Storefronts often appear empty for years as legal issues, renovations, etc. take place, but are not rentable. Total vacancies includes both rentable, and nomentable vacancies.
