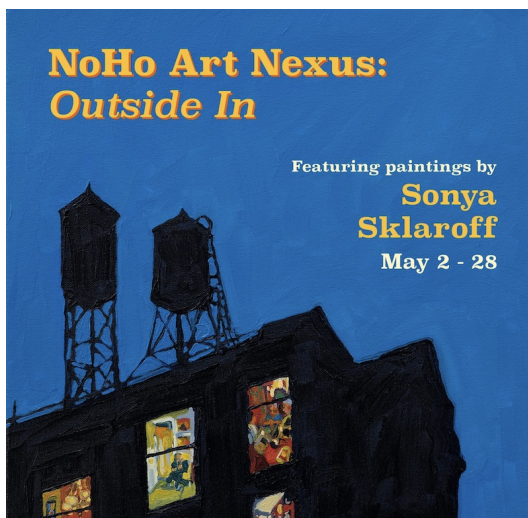

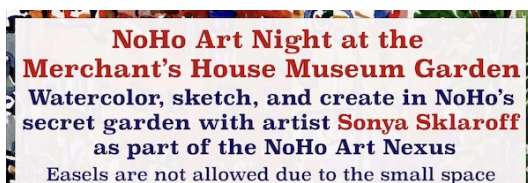
It's Not Too Late to See the NoHo Art Nexus

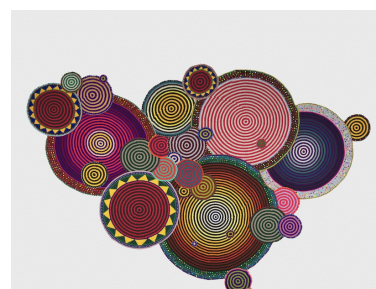
NoHo Business Corner: Astor Center
